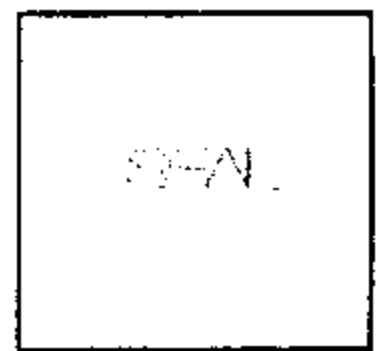

### 5. WHY AFFIANT BELIEVES THE SOURCE OF INFORMATION:

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On 08-23-2012, Detectives were notified of an abduction of a three day old baby (Identified as victim Bryce Coleman) from Magee Womens Hospital.

Multiple City of Pittsburgh Police Units responded to Magee Womens Hospital to conduct a search for the baby and the abductor. Once on scene, Police were briefed by hospital staff and the baby's mother, identified as Rhonda King as to the events of what happened.

At 1341 hours, Police were advised that a black female (later identified as Breona Moore) clad in hospital scrubs was loitering in front of room 2707 of Magee Womens Hospital. An employee of Magee Womens Hospital approached Moore and asked her if she was going on duty or getting off duty. The employee asked Moore this question because Moore did not possess a Magee Womens Hospital employee identification. Moore told the employee that she was getting off duty.

A second hospital employee approached Moore as she was still standing in the area of room 2707. Moore stated that she was the sister of the patient in room 2707. Moore told the employee that she was waiting to drive her sister home. When the discharge nurse entered into Kings room (2707), Moore followed her into the room.

King believed that Moore was a nurses aide employed by Magee Womens Hospital. Moore watched as Bryce and King's security wrist bands were removed by the discharge nurse. The discharge nurse then left the room. Moore approached King and took the baby from King and told her that one more physical test needed to be conducted on the baby and that she would return Bryce right away. Moore then walked out of room 2707 with Bryce.

Moore then went to a secluded area in the hospital and placed the baby in a reddish colored cloth zippered handbag. Moore then exited the hospital by way of the main lobby and out the front door. Moore was last seen on Halket Street leaving the hospital grounds.

Detectives learned that Moore fled the area after she heard Police sirens. Detectives also learned that Moore boarded a Port Authority bus to the Downtown section of the City of Pittsburgh. During the course of the investigation, information was developed that the baby and the suspect were seen in the Finance Building, which is located on Fourth St, Downtown Pittsburgh.

Police Units converged on this building in search of Moore and Bryce. Moore was located hiding in a closet with the baby. Moore was placed into custody and transported to the City of Pittsburgh Headquarters where she was interviewed by Detectives Rush and Satler. Moore admitted to planning and following through with the kidnapping of a new born baby. A brief synopsis of Moore's plan, as stated by her is as follows:

Moore stated she had convinced people that she was pregnant and told people she just had a baby. Moore had told people that she was scheduled for a "C-Section" on 08-20-12. Moore then told people that the baby was sick and would be released from the hospital on Thursday, 08-23-12.

The baby was transported back to Magee Womens Hospital.



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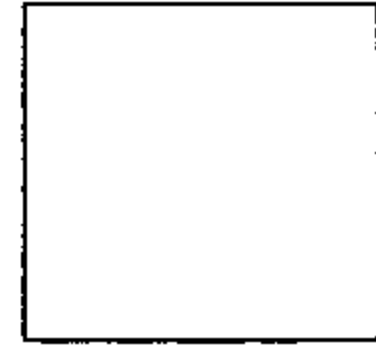
